

REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL

August 16, 2021

Council met in regular session with Mayor Burk presiding. Roll call was taken, and the following members were present: Davis, Rogers, Ranes, Butts, Wood, Johnston and Patterson. City Administrator, City Clerk and Chief of Police were present along with several guests.

Invocation was given by Mayor Burk.

Council reviewed the agenda motion was made by Johnston; seconded by Wood to approve agenda as written. 7-0 Motion Carried

Public Hearing: Mayor Burk requested motion to open the close out hearing for the Pool CDBG Project; Grant #19-NC-004. Motion was made by Wood; seconded by Johnston to open the hearing. 7-0 Motion Carried Carey Spoon with Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission presented the scope of services performed on the construction of the new pool. Once the presentation was completed the hearing was opened for questions from council and the public. No one had any questions.

- 1. American Rescue Plan Funds: Council had discussion with Carey Spoon about the American Rescue Plan and the services that the Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission can provide to ensure the City of Caney complies with the rules. Council was provided with handouts. No Action Taken
- 2. Set Public Hearing Date to Close CDBG-V Program: Motion was made by Johnston; seconded by Wood to set the public hearing for September 20, 2021. 7-0 Motion Carried
- 3. Discussion of 100 Mile Sale on September 10th & 11th: Caney Betterment Group would like permission to setup three porta potties in Wark Park along with allowing vendors to setup in the park during the event. During the discussion it was decided that no vendors would be allowed to set up on 4th Ave. Porta potties will be setup on Ridgeway and Vendors would be setup along Hooker St. and city will block it off. Motion was made by Rogers; seconded by Wood to approve. 6-1(Davis) Motion Carried

- 4. Printing of Rack Cards for 100 Mile Sale: Councilmember Wood is working with the Caney Valley Antique Tractor Club to create the rack cards for the 100 Mile Sale. The printing will be done by Kopco and Councilmember Wood would like for the city to pay the cost of the printing. The cost is going to be \$500.00, and it was suggested that the payment come out of the Tourism Fund. Motion was made by Rogers; seconded by Johnston to pay the cost of the printing out of the Tourism Fund. 6-1(Davis) Motion Carried
