Council met in special session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, December 6th with Mayor Burk presiding. Meeting was called to order and roll call was taken. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Discussion of Job Descriptions and Wage Scale: Waiting on information from Sedan, Ks and Dewey Ok. No Action Taken

BUSINESS:

- 1. Assistant Grocery Store Manager: After reviewing some of the recommendations on the proposed pay scales Councilmember Patterson felt council should increase the wages for the assistant manager at the Caney Market to the minimum proposed wage of \$15.00 per hour. Motion was made by Patterson; seconded by Rogers to increase the assistant managers pay to \$15.00 per hour. 6-1(Davis) Motion Carried
- 2. CDBG Extension of Time on Phase II Sewer Work: Received letter from CDBG to extend time on the Phase II project. Motion was made by Patterson; seconded by Johnston to allow Mayor to sign the extension. 7-0 Motion Carried
- 3. 2021 Budget Amendment: Motion was made by Wood; seconded by Johnston to set the hearing date to amend the 2021 Budget on December 20, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. 7-0 Motion Carried

- (A) Proposed Resolution: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY CANEY, KANSAS, APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN AGREEMENT TO RELEASE AND ASSIGN THE CITY'S OPIOID CLAIMS TO THE KANSAS ATTORNEY GENERAL AND CERTIFYING COSTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND ADDICTION MITIGATION IN EXCESS OF \$500. Motion was made by Rogers; seconded by Patterson to approve. 7-0 Motion Carried
