Admin Notes: With the minimal amounts of rain the Caney Valley area has been receiving, the city is watching water levels daily to make sure water is rolling over the river intake lock. The condition of Timber Hill Laker at this time being more than 8 feet below normal levels for this time of the year only gives Caney some 2-3 months of surplus water for the Little Caney river before emergency measures will have to be taken. Without sufficient rainfall for runoff water and temperatures rise to 90 degrees and above causing substantial evaporation, measures may have to be enacted very quickly for water conservation.
