RESOLUTION 1419

A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE FINGERPRINT FEES FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE CANEY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-108 of the City Code, a fingerprint fee in the amount of \$50.00 is to be assessed against any defendant convicted of violating a municipal ordinance that prohibits conduct comparable to a Class A or B misdemeanor, or assault as defined in K.S.A. 21-5412, and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended the fees generated from such fingerprint services be designated for the purchase of equipment for the Caney Police Department, such as a digital fingerprint machine; and

WHEREAS, the use of such funds will increase the efficiency of the Caney Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Caney, Kansas, that City staff be and is hereby authorized and directed to establish a fund for the deposit of court-related fingerprint fees, to be referred to as the "Fingerprint Fund".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned Fingerprint Fund is hereby designated to be used solely for the purchase of equipment for the Caney Police Department, as recommended by the Chief of Police on requisitions to be approved by the City Council.
